The Kerala State Higher Education Council strives to promote equity and excellence in higher education through thoughtful reforms and innovation. The stress is on providing a level playing field to students from diverse backgrounds, ensuring that pupils from all backgrounds have the opportunity to fulfill their aspirations and nurture their talents.

HIGHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME

A scholarship scheme was launched by Dr. Manmohan Singh, the Prime Minister of India in Thiruvananthapuram, on 3rd January 2010.

The general scholarship scheme is for students pursuing the study of Sciences. Social Sciences, Business Studies and Humanities through full time courses at the undergraduate and post graduate levels in government aided colleges, departments and institutions under the universities in Kerala. In future, the Council plans to extend the Scholarship to other disopines and students pursuing studies outside the State, through endowments.

MOBILIZATION OF FUNDS

The funds required for the scheme would be raised through a system of public-private collaboration.

The Council would receive two types of funds from the general public. General Funds and Endowment funds.

General fund - any amount of donor's choice.

Endowment fund - ₹5 lakhs, and above.

A corpus fund of ₹100 crore will be required to finance the scholarships.

STRUCTURE OF THE SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME

Number and amount of scholarships

First Year Degree - 1000 scholarships at ₹1,2000 per year

Second Year Degree - 1000 scholarships at ₹18000 per year

Third Year Degree - 1000 scholarships at ₹ 24000 per year

First Year P.G. - 600 scholarships at ₹ 40000 per year

Final Year P.G. - 600 scholarships at ₹ 60000 per year

25% extra for physically challenged students.

The percentage of reservation of scholarships

for different categories

10% for students who belong to SC/ST categories,

3% for physically challenged students.

10% for students belonging to BPL families,

27% for students who belong to OBC category,

50% for the students in general category.



ELIGIBILITY FOR THE AWARD

The required minimum percentage of marks for applying for the scholarship.

ST: Pass

SC - For Business studies: 60%

SC - All other subjects: 55%

PC: 45%

BPL / OBC - For Science subjects: 60%

For Business studies: 65%

For other subjects: 55%

General -

For Science & Business studies: 75%

For other subjects: 60%

The selection of the candidates will be purely on the basis of merit in accordance with criteria laid down by Higher Education Council. The Council will select the scholars in each university on the basis of their total marks/overall grade in the qualifying examination, considered stream wise.

The scholarships are initially sanctioned for one year only. Renewal during second and third year degree course and first and second years of PG course will depend on the scholar's performance in the previous semester/year examinations.

ENDOWMENT SCHEME

Endowment of ₹5 Lakhs. One scholarship for 5 years; every 5 years.

Endowment of ₹15 Lakhs. One scholarship for 5 years; every year.

Endowment of ₹25 Lakhs. Fund for advanced studies, within and outside the country.

PRIVILEGES OF ENDOWMENT DONORS

To name the endowments instituted by them.

To select the subject/course for which endowments are meant for

To select the universities in which scholarships could be instituted.

To decide income limit/category of students.

Contributions eligible for tax exemption

The contribution to scholarship fund is eligible for income tax deduction u/s 80G(5) of the Income Tax Act 1961.

THE COUNCIL

The organizational structure of the Council consists of three bodies - Advisory Council, Governing Council and Executive Council.

The Advisory Council has 32 members, which includes the Chief Minister, Minister for Education, Minister for Health, Minister for Law, Minister for Agriculture, Leader of Opposition in the Assembly, Representatives of the members of the Parliament from the State, Members of the State Legislature (with reservation for SC/ST, and women) Members of three tier Panchayaths, Members of Municipalities, Members of Corporations and emineral personalities from different walks of life.

A 35 member high power body chained by the Minister for Education. Kerala, the Governing Council is responsible for taking final decisions on all policy matters on behalf of the Council. The other members include Vice-chancellors of the state universities, eminent educationists, elected representatives of the academic councils of state universities, nominated representatives of student unions and higher officials of the State in the ranks of secretaries and directors of various departments.

The Executive council is a 9 member body chained by the Vice-Chairman of the Council. Apart from the Vice-Chairman, this body will include a full time Member Secretary, five part-time members, one Vice-Chancellor and the Secretary to Government, Higher Education.
