# KIRF RANKING 2024

## KERALA INSTITUTIONAL RANKING FRAMEWORK (KIRF)

Kerala Institutional Ranking Framework (KIRF) is a comprehensive ranking system for Higher Education Institutions in the state to ensure the quality of education. KIRF envisages assessing institutional performance maintaining its sustainability and providing access to higher education with equal opportunity for all eligible persons, identifying the institutions to collaborate, improving their national/ state institutional level ranking etc. KIRF has been developed based on the NIRF model. It ranks educational institutions under 12 categories such as Universities, Colleges, Engineering, Management, Architecture, Medical, Dental, Pharmacy, Nursing, Law, Teacher Education and Agriculture and Allied Sectors. An Oversight Committee led by Prof. Gangan Pratap, Former Director of CSIR and Former Vice Chancellor of Cochin University of Science and Technology was formed for KIRF. The framework was launched on May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2023 by Dr. R Bindu, Minister for Higher Education and Social Justice at C.V. Raman Hall, CLIF, University of Kerala, Kariavattom. A dedicated portal for KIRF was developed for uploading institutional data.

The educational institutions are ranked under KIRF based on the 5 metrics/parameters, which are listed below:

1. **Teaching Learning and Resources (TLR)**- TLR assess the core activities of an educational institution. This can be attained through assessing the Student Strength (SS), Faculty Student Ratio (FSR), Faculty Qualification and Experience (FQE), Online Education (OE)

Subscription to e-journals (SEJ) and Financial Resources and Utilisation (FRU).

2. **Knowledge Dissemination and Research Excellence (KDRE)-** Knowledge Dissemination and Research Excellence are pivotal components in assessing an institution's impact and reputation in the academic and professional spheres. KDRE is assessed by Research Productivity (RP), Research Impact (RI), Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) and Research Footprint and Consultancy Startups (RFCS).
3. **Graduation Outcome (GO)-** KIRF focus on Graduation Outcome with a regional perspective tailored to the specific needs and context of institutions in Kerala. The key aspects of Graduation Outcome include Metric for University Examination (GUE), Metric for Entrance Examinations (GEE-UGC/NET/JRF/CSIR/GATE/GRE) and Placement and Higher Studies (PH).
4. **Outreach and Inclusivity (OI)-** The "Outreach and Inclusivity" metric in the Kerala Institutional Ranking Framework (KIRF) evaluates how effectively institutions engage with diverse communities and ensure broad access to education. This aspect is crucial for understanding institution's commitment to social responsibility and equitable educational opportunities. Key components are Region Diversity (RD), First Generation Learners (FGL), Facilities for Differently Abled Students (FDA) and Social Inclusiveness (SI).
5. **Scientific Temper and Secular Outlook (STSO)-** It reflects the commitment to fostering an environment that promotes rational thinking, evidence-based practices and its inclusivity. STSO is a

qualitative metric and is assessed by evaluating Imparting Scientific Temper and Secular Outlook (STSO), Adoption of Green Technology (GT) and Accreditation and Rankings (AR).

The inclusion of state-specific parameters such as Scientific Temper, Secular Outlook (STSO), and First-Generation Learners (FGL) distinguishes KIRF from NIRF, reflecting its focus on Kerala's unique educational priorities and social relevance.

## **Ranking Methodology**

The Kerala Institutional Ranking Framework (KIRF) uses a combination of primary and secondary data to evaluate and rank institutions. Primary data, including quantitative metrics and qualitative write-ups on initiatives like *Scientific Temper*, *Secular Outlook*, and *Green Technology*, were collected through an online system developed by KSHEC, while secondary data on publications, citations, and h-index were sourced from Web of Science (WoS) and Scopus. Data anomalies were identified and clarified through communication with institutions, with documentary evidence requested as needed. Research-related metrics were validated by CSIR-NIScPR, ensuring accuracy through manual verification and bibliometric analysis, while patents were assessed using the Indian Patent Advanced Search System (InPASS). Institutions' performance across indicators such as academic quality, research output, faculty credentials, infrastructure, and financial metrics were scored and weighted to calculate a composite score. Data collection was facilitated through a standardized online system that minimized errors and streamlined submissions.

The KIRF assigns different weightages to each parameter based on its relevance, such as:

Teaching, Learning and Resources- 30%

Knowledge Dissemination and Research Excellence- 30%

Graduation Outcomes- 20%

Outreach and Inclusivity-10%

Scientific Temper and Secular Outlook-10%

In the first edition of KIRF, institutions were ranked within specific categories, including Universities, Colleges, Engineering, Nursing, Teacher Education, and Agriculture and Allied Sectors. These categories were chosen to encompass the diverse range of higher education institutions in Kerala, recognizing their unique strengths and focus areas. By scoring institutions based on comprehensive criteria, the framework provided an accurate representation of their comparative performance within each category. However, due to insufficient participation from institutions in certain fields, categories such as Management, Architecture, Medical, Dental, Pharmacy, and Law were excluded from this edition of the rankings. The lack of adequate representation in these areas prevented a fair and meaningful comparison, prompting their exclusion. This decision underscores KIRF's commitment to maintaining the integrity and reliability of the ranking process. The inclusion of only sufficiently represented categories ensures that the rankings remain credible and relevant, providing valuable insights to students, educators, and policymakers while setting a foundation for broader participation in future editions. This adaptive approach demonstrates KIRF's dedication to fostering continuous improvement and inclusivity within Kerala's higher education ecosystem.

## **Ranking of HEIs**

In the University category, all 10 participating universities were individually ranked, providing a comprehensive evaluation of their contributions to higher education. The College category featured a detailed ranking system, with institutions ranked 1 to 100 individually, while those ranked 101 to 150 were grouped under Rank Band-I promoting a nuanced understanding of institutional performance. In the Engineering category, institutions ranked 1 to 50 were listed individually, while those ranked 51 to 65 were grouped under Rank Band-I. Similarly, in the Teacher Education category, institutions ranked 1 to 10 were individually listed, with those ranked 11 to 38 grouped under Rank Band-I. In the Nursing category, one institution achieved an individual ranking, while institutions ranked 2 to 10 were included in Rank Band-I. For the Agriculture category, institutions ranked 1 to 5 were individually listed, and those ranked 6 to 9 were grouped under Rank Band-I. This tiered approach ensures fairness, highlights excellence, and provides institutions with benchmarks for continuous improvement across the higher education ecosystem in Kerala.

# KIRF announces rankings for 2024

The Kerala Institutional Ranking Framework (KIRF) has announced rankings for higher education institutions in the State.

While the Cochin University of Science and Technology (Cusat) topped the ranking of universities, the University of Kerala and Mahatma Gandhi University are in the second and third positions respectively.

University College, Thiruvananthapuram, is in the first position among arts and science colleges, followed by Rajagiri College of Social Sciences (Autonomous), Ernakulam, in the second place and St.

Teresa's College (Autonomous), Ernakulam, in the third.

The College of Engineering, Trivandrum, is the top engineering college, while Government Engineering College, Thrissur, and TKM College of Engineering, Kollam, are in the second and third places.

While the Government College of Teacher Education, Kozhikode, secured first place among teacher education colleges, Farook Training College, Kozhikode, and PKM College of Education, Madampam, Kannur, are in the second and third positions.

College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Pookode, Wayanad, is the best agriculture and allied college. College of Veterinary

and Animal Sciences, Mananthy, Thrissur, and College of Forestry, Thrissur, secured the second and third places.

Only one nursing college, Government College of Nursing, Thiruvananthapuram, secured place in the ranking list.

Announcing the rankings here on Friday, Higher Education Minister R. Bindu said the new ranking system launched by the Left Democratic Front government aims to improve the national and international rankings of the State's higher education institutions and help students choose institutions based on quality. Kerala becomes the first State in the country to implement such a State-level ranking

framework. The KIRF system was introduced by the Department of Higher Education and the Kerala State Higher Education Council (KHEC) to improve the quality of education in State's universities and colleges. It has been developed on the model of the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) guidelines, she said.

## 12 sectors

A total of 449 higher education institutions participated in the first KIRF rankings. The institutions were categorised into 12 different sectors.

## Govt releases 1st ranking of higher edu institutions; Cusat tops univs

It's for the first time in country that a state govt has ventured into ranking its higher edu firms

THE GOVERNMENT on Friday released its first ranking of universities and colleges in the state under the Kerala Institutional Ranking Framework (KIRF). Cochin University of Science and Technology (Cusat) took the top honour among universities.

It is for the first time in the country that a state government has ventured into ranking its higher education institutions. Launched on May 1, 2024, KIRF was adopted by the Kerala State Higher Education Council (KHEC) as the methodology for the rankings. KIRF was introduced for continuous evaluation of higher educational institutions, so that they perform better and improve their position in national and international rankings. Our framework for evaluating universities and colleges follows the national framework. Factors unique to the state were also incorporated. We introduced a portal as part of the effort," Higher Education Minister R. Bindu said, announcing the rankings.

The portal was opened for uploading institutional data on July 5, 2024. The process was closed on May 10 this year.

A total of 449 institutions were part of the rankings. This included 10 universities, 216 arts and science colleges, 79 engineering colleges, seven management institutions, 10 medical colleges, eight dental colleges, six pharmacy colleges,

## Cusat, Kerala Univ bag top honours in state's rankings

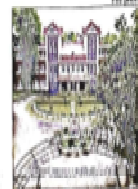
2-Day Int'l Conclave On Higher Education Begins On Jan 15

Thiruvananthapuram: Higher education minister R. Bindu on Friday announced the maiden rankings of educational institutions in state as per Kerala Institutional Ranking Framework (KIRF) system, introduced last year on the lines of National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF).

At a news conference, Bindu said as per KIRF, Cochin University of Science and Technology (Cusat) won the top position, among the ten universities in the state, while Kerala University ranked second. Mahatma Gandhi University bagged the third rank while Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University was placed fourth.

Curiously, Sri Sarikara Charya University of Sarakrit, Kollam, and National University of Advanced Legal

Mahatma Gandhi University bagged the third rank while Kerala Veterinary and Animal Sciences University was placed fourth.

Studies (Maula) are placed in the ninth and tenth positions, respectively.

Among Arts & Science colleges, University College, Thiruvananthapuram, bagged the top position while Rajagiri College of Social Sciences (Autonomous), Ernakulam, was ranked second. St Teresa's College (Autonomous), Ernakulam, and St Joseph's

College, Devagiri in Kozhikode were in third and fourth positions, Bindu said. "In all, 216 colleges had participated in the rankings, and of them 100 were ranked individually. Those ranked 101-150 were grouped under rank band 1, providing a nuanced understanding of institutional performance," she added.

She said 72 engineering colleges participated in the ranking process, and 50 of them were ranked individually, while those ranked 51-60 were grouped under rank band 1, regrouped under rank band 1, College of Engineering, Trivandrum, ranked first while Government College of Engineering, Kollam, and Rajagiri School of Engineering and Technology (Autonomous), Ernakulam, came third and fourth in this category.

Bindu also announced the

rankings of institutions in sectors like education, nursing and agriculture and allied sciences as per the KIRF system.

The educational institutions were ranked under KIRF based on five metrics/parameters. They cover areas like teaching learning and resources (TLR) which assess the co-revivification of an educational institution.

Efforts were made to give the ranking system a regional perspective by including specific needs and contexts of institutions in the graduation outcome matrix, she added.

An international conclave on higher education will be jointly organized by the state higher education department and higher education council, said Bindu. The two-day event "Shaping Kerala's Future: International Conclave on State Higher Education" will be held at Cusat from Jan 15.
